It's Game Time!

Get ready for some Super Bowl excitement while supporting a great cause! The Foundation is thrilled to announce the return of our “**Super Bowl Squares**” Fundraiser for 2025! Tickets will be sold the week of **February 3rd–8th**:

- **Monday, February 3rd:** 10am-12pm
- **Tuesday, February 4th:** 10am-12pm
- **Wednesday, February 5th:** 1pm-3pm
- **Thursday, February 6th:** 10am-12pm
- **Friday, February 7th:** 1pm-3pm
- **Saturday, February 8th:** 10am-12pm

Game Day: The Super Bowl is on **February 9th**, so don't miss your chance to participate!

Here's how it works:

A grid consists of 10 vertical columns and 10 horizontal rows, both numbered from 0 to 9 (numbers will be assigned at random after the ticket sales close). One team will be assigned to the columns, and the other team to the rows.

Each square is just \$5 per square, and there's no limit to how many squares you can buy.

At the end of the Super Bowl, the person whose square corresponds with the second digit of each team's final score will win 50% of the pot! The other 50% will go directly to the Foundation to support our not-for-profit home.

For example, if the final score is 14-7, the winning square would be located at row 4, column 7. In determining the winner, we use the final score at the end of the 4th quarter (or overtime, if applicable).

What happens if squares remain unsold?

Any unpurchased squares will automatically contribute to the Foundation's portion of the proceeds, ensuring every dollar supports our community. Let's make this year's Super Bowl even more exciting while helping the Foundation make a difference.
